Red, White and Blue Jello Poke Cake

Ingredients:

1, 16.25 ounce box of white cake mix (and ingredients needed to make it) 3 ounces of cherry flavored Jello 3 ounces of berry blue flavored Jello 1 1/2 cups of boiling water, divided 1 cup of cold water, divided



1, 8 ounce container of frozen whipped topping, thawed sprinkles to decorate

Directions:

Prepare box of cake mix according to package directions for a 9x13 cake. Bake in your preheated oven until a tooth pick inserted in the center comes out clean.

Remove from oven and place onto a wire rack to cool for a few minutes. Using a clean wooden spoon handle, poke holes into the top of the cake. Let cake cool completely.

In a bowl or large cup, add cherry flavored Jello.

Add 3/4 cup of boiling water and stir together until the Jello is completely dissolved.

Then add 1/2 cup of cold water and stir together well. Set aside.

In another bowl or large cup, repeat the steps to make the berry blue flavored Jello.

Using a spoon or a squirt bottle, carefully pour the red Jello into alternating holes.

Then fill the remaining holes with the blue Jello.

Chill in the refrigerator for several hours, or preferably overnight, to set up.

Then evenly spread whipped topping over the top.

Decorate with sprinkles.
